Shoulder to Soldier Veterans Charity - Community Allotment February 2018

For this project, we gladly donated 10m^2 of our Hy-Pave EKG 1 Porous Cellular Paver to the armed forces charity, *Shoulder to Soldier*. We supplied this to the charity's communal allotment which enabled disabled veterans to participate in the garden more. In the past, the veterans were left frustrated that they couldn't have easy access to the allotment, as their restricted mobility and the lack of flat ground made it difficult to enjoy a trip to see their friends down at the allotment. This product was used to create a pathway towards their veterans memorial.
